The Fund qualifies as a 'Maltese UCITS'. The Fund offers different share classes which may include different features as disclosed in the Fund's Offering Supplement and PRIIP KID applicable to relevant share class. Shares class may be designated as either 'Accumulator' or 'Distributor'. An 'Accumulator' share class shall re-invest all income attributed to such share class and is reflected in the share price. A 'Distributor' share class shall distribute all or part of the income attributed to such share class.

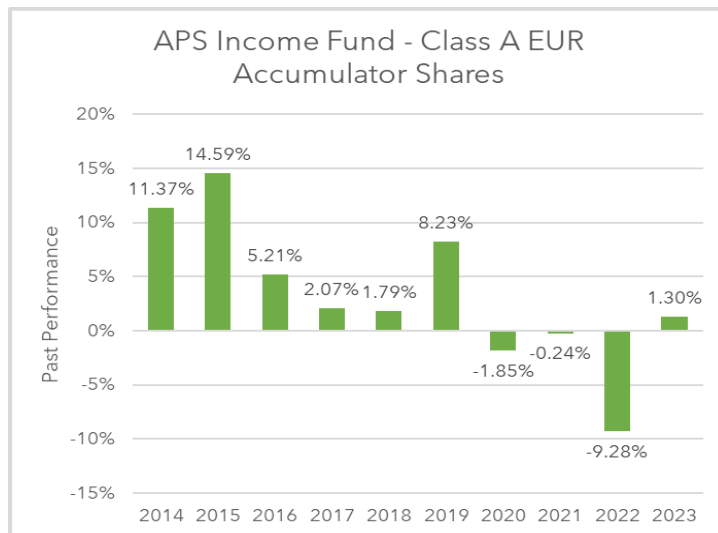
